1. Background and objectives

For several years, the Asian Cultural Centre for UNESCO (ACCU) has been conducting the Project for the Development of ESD Evaluation Methods¹ in which members, mainly schoolteachers, have been discussing how to evaluate ESD in schools and what methods would be most effective. In this forum, we will introduce the results of these discussions and the current initiatives being conducted.

Meanwhile, ESD incorporated into community learning takes on a different evaluation approach from that of schools. We would like to take this opportunity to think about school-community collaboration and how it would lead to the creation of a sustainable society by sharing various evaluation methods and learning from one another through this forum.

As an event associated with the UNESCO Future Co-Creation Platform in Japan² which aims to realize a sustainable society based on UNESCO activities by bringing together various stakeholders, this forum will be held to discuss the future of ESD evaluation by looking at ESD evaluation from the perspectives of both schools and communities, and by sharing findings and knowledge from home and abroad.
