Who can apply:

Early career researchers (no age limit) who are working on or have conducted research on intangible cultural heritage (ICH) in the Asia-Pacific Region and have little or no experience of publishing a research paper, such as:

- Graduate students and postdoctoral researchers
- ✓ Researchers having recently started working on ICH-related topics
- ✓ Researchers working for NGOs, government agencies, museums, etc.
- \checkmark ICH practitioners who have been involved in research

Application guidelines:

Interested applicants should complete and submit the **online application form**, which includes:

- ✓ 500-word summary of your research topic, approach and methodology
- ✓ Brief statement of approximately 500 words, summarizing your research background and why you would like to participate in the programme
- ✓ Short CV using the <u>downloadable form</u>

After screening of all submitted documents, selected applicants will be invited for an online interview.
